Northern Lite truck campers come with a spacious patio bumper that extends past the truck hitch. To hook up your trailer you simply need to add on a hitch extension which clears the bumper.



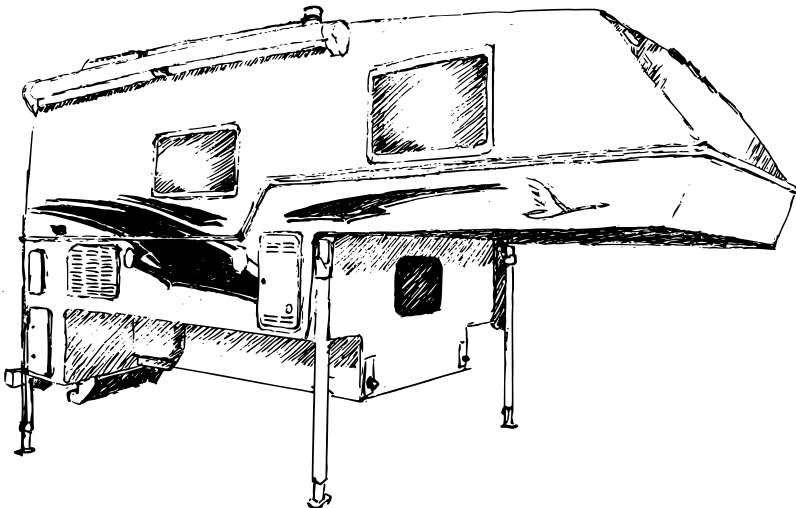
WHEN THE ROAD ENDS, KEEP GOING

If you have ever looked at a tight, winding, forest service road covered in potholes and decided not to go up it because you were towing a trailer or driving a larger RV, you understand the value of a truck camper.

Thanks to a tight turning radius and short overall wheelbase, truck campers provide the ability to easily explore roads and off-road areas that would otherwise be challenging, if not impossible, with a trailer or Class A RV. With a truck camper, every road is an option.

Northern Lite not only builds long box truck campers for trucks with 8' beds but we also build short box campers for those that want a shorter wheelbase to get into even more extreme areas and enable easy city driving.

Thanks to our two-piece fiberglass design, there's no heavy framing in the walls of our campers which means Northern Lite truck campers have a low center of gravity relative to not only other RV classes, but also to models from other truck camper manufacturers. This low center of gravity further improves the ability to travel over challenging terrain with your truck camper.



Truck campers have all the conveniences that you will find in other RV classes, just placed in a smaller overall footprint.

All Northern Lite truck campers include all of the comforts of home, including a full bathroom with shower, either wet bath or dry bath configurations; a full kitchen with sink, stove and 2-way fridge; a dinette area that sits 4 and converts into a bed; plus a huge main sleeping area with a full sized queen bed. To keep the temperature just right there's a 20,000 BTU furnace and optional air conditioner... all packaged in an insulated two-piece fiberglass shell that will keep you warm and dry no matter what Mother Nature throws at you.

LONG BOX VS. SHORT BOX

One of the decisions that you need to make when buying a truck camper is the choice between Long Box and Short Box setups.

Long Box campers built by Northern Lite are designed for 8-foot truck beds. Short Box campers are designed for 6.5-foot truck beds.

Short Box camper setups are ideal for those owners that prefer mobility, both in the bush and around town. Short box trucks are the preferred choice for daily drivers.

Long Box camper setups are designed for owners that are willing to sacrifice some mobility for extra space and greater payload.



EXPLORING VAN LIFE?

If you are interested in exploring the van life lifestyle, a truck camper could be the perfect option for you.

Not only are truck campers purpose built for exactly what Van Lifers are looking to do, they provide much more room and comfort than most van set ups. Plus, truck campers provide greater versatility, both in what you can do with them but also where they can take you.

If you are looking to live full time in a van and explore the endless road, a Northern Lite truck camper could be a much better option for you.

WHAT ABOUT SLIDES?

Northern Lite truck campers are built for a certain type of person. We build campers for adventurers that are looking for a top of the line true 4-season truck camper.

This means that none of the campers we build use a slide to create additional space.

The reason we don't use slides is simple. Along with adding several hundred pounds to the weight of a camper, slides result in a significant leak point for cold air and moisture, which goes against our view of what constitutes a true 4-season truck camper.

ARE TRUCK CAMPERS SUITABLE FOR EVERY RVER?

If you are looking to sleep 5 or more people in your RV on a regular basis, or if you need lots of space to walk around while inside, then a truck camper is probably not for you. Most truck campers provide sleeping space for two adults in the cabover area and a sleeping area for one adult or two children in the dinette area.

Truck campers are also not a great option for those RVer's that don't want to worry about loading and unloading the camper from a truck. Those same RVer's are probably not a good match for trailers either and should probably look at Class A or Class C recreation vehicles.



If your priority in selecting an RV is versatility and not the number of people it can hold, then a truck camper is a great option for you.
