



Truck Jump Start And Battery Replacement Service Bulletin

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To all Dealers and Owners,

If the truck battery becomes discharged and requires a jump start or the battery is being replaced, the 7-way power connection and DC-DC charger connection (if equipped on a lithium power system) must be removed from the truck camper prior to performing a jump start or replacing the truck battery.

The high currents required to jump start a truck battery could be harmful to the camper's electrical system and wiring.

The figures below show the connections which need to be disconnected when jump starting a truck or replacing a truck battery.
